

SECTION 11. That Subsection (a) Section 49-47, "Pretreatment," of Article IV, "Water Quality," of CHAPTER 49, "WATER AND WASTEWATER," of the Dallas City Code, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

“(a) Traps/interceptors required. The owner or operator of premises from which industrial waste is discharged shall provide grease and sand traps/interceptors for the proper handling of liquid wastes containing grease, floatable substances, or sand. The traps/interceptors must be of a type and capacity approved by the director to adequately handle grease and sand and must be located so that they are easily accessible for cleaning, inspection, and monitoring. Grease and sand traps/interceptors must be cleaned in such a manner that the volume of grease or sand trap/interceptor waste removed from each trap/interceptor equals the nominal volume capacity of each respective trap/interceptor whenever it is cleaned. A grease trap/interceptor located upon the premises of a food service establishment must be 100 percent pumped out at least the earlier of:

- (1) every 90 days; or
- (2) when at least 25 percent or more of the wetted height of the grease trap/interceptor, as measured from the bottom of the grease trap/interceptor to the invert of the outlet pipe, contains floating materials, sediment, oils, or grease.”

SECTION 12. That, unless specifically provided otherwise by this ordinance or by state law, a person violating a provision of this ordinance governing fire safety, zoning, or public health and sanitation, including dumping of refuse, is, upon conviction, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000 and that a person violating any other provision of this ordinance is, upon conviction, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.

SECTION 13. That CHAPTERS 19 and 49 of the Dallas City Code, as amended, will remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 14. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by Section 1-4 of CHAPTER 1 of the Dallas City Code, as amended.


